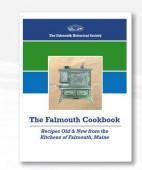

Economics of merchandise sales

Fair Sales

Less cost recovery for new merchandise	\$111
Less state sales tax	\$23
Net profit	\$236

Sales at events MUST track every item sold, amount paid, and method of payment!

The "or else" doesn't bear contemplation

- Take out 5.5% of all sales for taxes
- Take out cost of new merchandise to pay off "loan"
- Take out cost of consignment merchandise
- What's left is net profit
